VOTER GUIDE FOR AMENDMENTS

YES - No. 1 Constitutional Amendment

On U.S. citizens can vote in federal, state, local, or school elections

NO - No. 2 Constitutional Amendment

Increase the state minimum wage to \$15 by 2026

NO - No. 3 Constitutional Amendment

Establishes top-two open primary system for state office primary elections

YES - No. 4 Constitutional Amendment

Requires voter approved constitutional amendments to be approved by voters at a second general election

YES - No. 5 Constitutional Amendment

Increases the period during which a person may transfer "Save Our Homes" benefits to a new homestead property

YES No. 6 Constitutional Amendment

Allows a homestead property tax discount to be transferred to the surviving spouse of a deceased veteran
